

Creative Writing Workshop: Writing Loss

How is it that loss both occupies as well as empties space? How can we think of writing, photography, and archiving as modes that can enable us to be in dialogue with that which has been lost? This workshop would use a series of writing prompts and a selection of photographs of the streetscapes of Pondicherry from IFP's Photo Archive to invite participants to work with archival photographs and writing as companionable forms that can store and also reshape the meaning of loss.

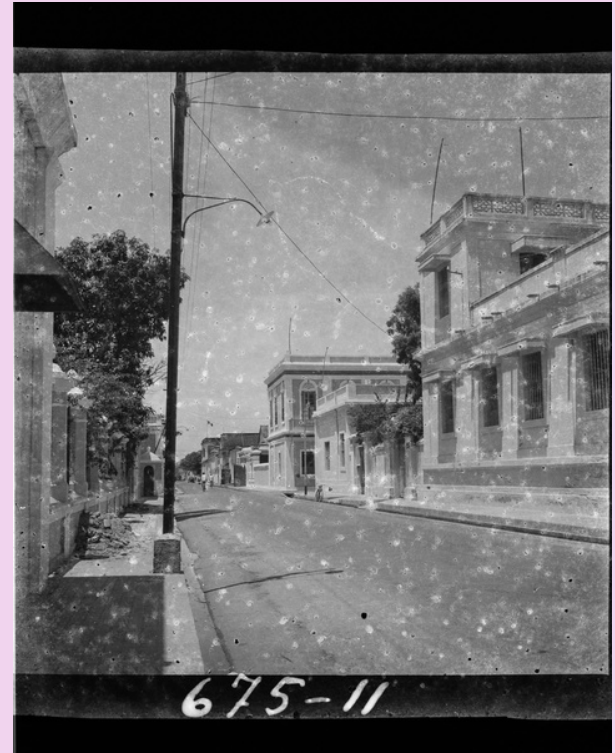
